Specific dates will be confirmed closer to the time. The experience will take place in the vicinity of the Strijdom Tunnel – a location that may remind them of their first Grade 9 expedition. Adventure will remain an integral part of this trip, and the skills and experiences gained during their time in the outdoor adventure lessons will undoubtedly come in handy. We kindly request that you do not dispose of, or pack away your adventure gear, as it will be put to good use during this trip.

The approximate cost per student for this Enrichment Tour will be around R4500, with the school subsidising the remaining expenses. We are genuinely excited about this upcoming adventure and the substantial value it will bring to their overall educational journey.
