## BADGE POLICY 2019

**Purpose:** To regulate the wearing of badges on Stanford Lake College uniform.

**1. Junior Achiever Badges (Tree Badge):**

Only ONE Junior Achiever Badge may be worn regardless of how many Junior Achiever certificates a pupil may have been awarded. The single Junior Achiever Badge shall represent all Junior Achiever certificates received. The Junior Achiever Badge may continue to be worn in the senior grades.

**2. Grade 12 Badges:**

All Grade 12s shall wear the school's Matric badge.

Members of PEX shall wear the school's PEX badge.

Heads of Sport Houses and Heads of Boarding Houses/Day Scholar House shall wear the appropriate badge.

Heads and Deputies of School shall wear the appropriate badge indicating their senior positions in the school.

**3. Round Square Exchange Badges:**

Pupils who have represented the school on local or international exchanges, may wear ONE badge to represent their exchange. This may be EITHER a badge of the country of their exchange OR a badge of the school which hosted them.

**4. Round Square Conference Badges:**

Pupils who attend local, regional or international Round Square conferences may wear ONE badge to represent the conference attended.

**5. President's Award Badges:**

Pupils who have qualified for bronze, silver or gold awards may wear the appropriate badge. Only the badge of the highest level achieved by the pupil may be worn.

**6. Tri-tech Badges:**

Pupils who take part in Tri-tech and who receive badges for their participation may wear ONE Tri-tech badge.

**7. Badger Badge:**

All pupils may wear the badger badge.

**8. Sport/Culture/Other Badges:**

Pupils who receive badges as recognition in Sport, Culture or any other activity may wear the appropriate badge only after being granted permission to do so by the school.

9. Pupils wishing to wear badges/insignia in support of a particular cause may do so only after gaining permission from the school which will also decide upon the period of time such badges/insignia may be worn for.

10. No pupil may wear a badge/insignia unless they have met the criteria which allows for that badge/insignia to be worn.

11. Approved badges/insignia may be worn on the school blazer only and not on any other form of school uniform.
